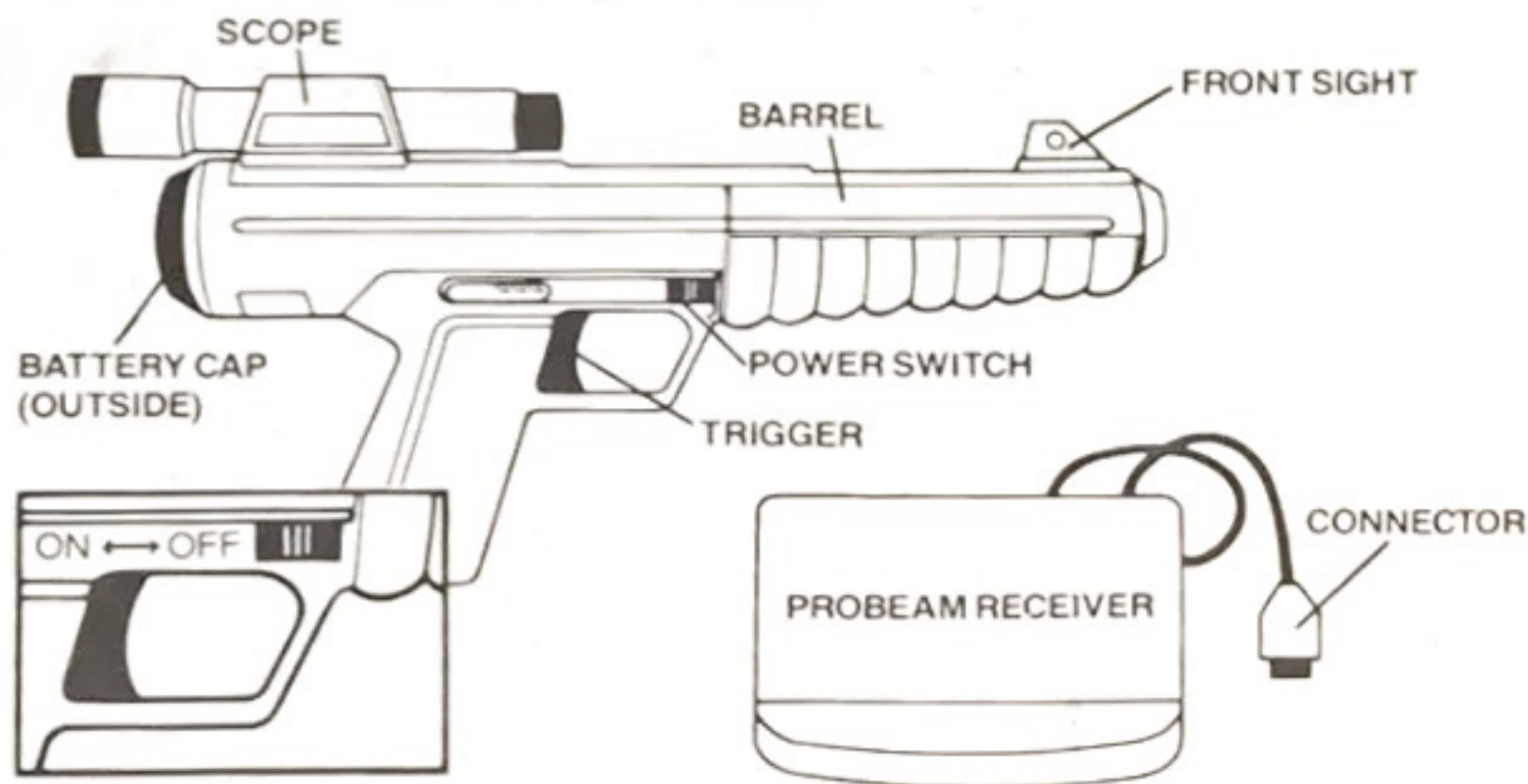
INTRODUCTION

THE DOMINATOR PROBEAM™ is a new type of high quality Gun that challenges your reflexes and quick judgment. It combines a light sensitive gun with video game fun.

To play with the PROBEAM you need:

- A) The Nintendo Entertainment System (NES)®
- B) A Light Gun Series Game Pak (NES Compatible)

GUN AND RECEIVER PARTS

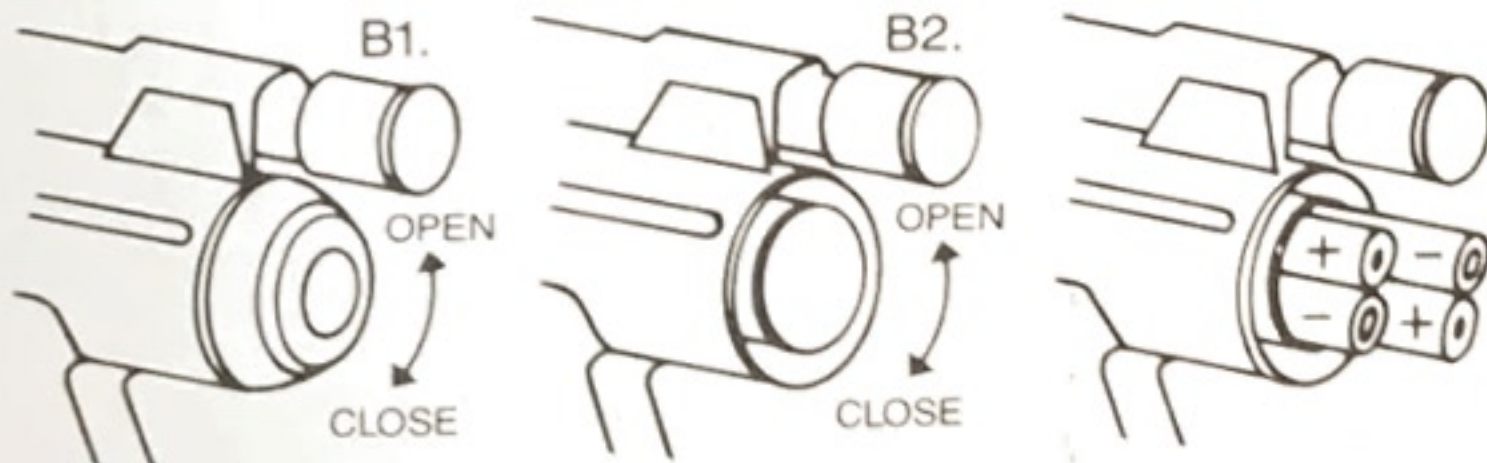


BATTERY INSTALLATION

PROBEAM requires 4 (four) "AAA" size batteries (not included).

To Install:

- A) Remove cap on the bottom of PROBEAM by turning cap as shown in illustration B1.
- B) Open inside cap as shown in Illustration B2.
- C) Insert batteries (be sure (+) and (-) on the batteries match the diagram inside battery compartment).



IF THE PROBEAM DOES NOT OPERATE CORRECTLY CHECK THE FOLLOWING:

- A) Are PROBEAM, TV, and NES system turned on?
- B) Is PROBEAM receiver plugged into socket 2 of the NES?
- C) Are batteries inserted correctly?
- D) Are batteries fresh? (If not replace)
- E) Is TV adjusted for high contrast?
- F) Have you inserted NES Light Gun Series Game Pak?
- G) Is the receiver in front of player?

CARE OF PROBEAM

- A) Do not drop.
- B) Do not point toward the sun.
- C) Do not store in extreme heat or cold.
- D) Always make sure power on NES is *OFF* before inserting or removing PROBEAM from unit.
- E) Make sure power on PROBEAM is *OFF* before changing batteries.
- F) Clean with soft cloth. Do not use volatile cleaners.
- G) Keep PROBEAM lens clean at all times.
- H) When disconnecting the plug of PROBEAM receiver from the control deck, grasp the connector and pull. Do not pull on the cord as damage may result.
- I) Make sure power on PROBEAM is always OFF when unit is not in use. (If unit is left on when not in use batteries will continue to drain slowly)
